All forms/reports will connect to a SQL backend database, and familiarity with SQL and ability to interpret, modify, and create SQL Views and Stored Procedures is required. In addition to Crystal Reports, some advanced reporting within Microsoft Excel or Procede's proprietary business intelligence tool may be required.
